## PRE-SCHOOL AND KINDERGARTEN

**My carefully prepared Montessori classroom is set up with a wide range of hands-on learning materials. Your child can experience and internalize a concept in a concrete way that is both interesting and relevant.**

### Montessori Philosophy & Curriculum Aims

The Pre-primary program provides concrete Montessori exercises, which enables children to learn many different concepts at their own pace and level of readiness.

The Kindergarten program further extends upon the concrete Montessori exercises the children participated in during the Pre-Primary program. The materials and lessons of the classrooms are arranged from simple to complex and concrete to abstract, so that the child may learn by choice of materials. Each piece of the Montessori apparatus is designed to give children a new experience and to develop a specific concept. Children qualifying for the Kindergarten Program are provided opportunities to work with advanced skills in Language, Math, Geography, Science, Social-Studies. Students also engage in Computers and Yoga in addition to Music and Arts and Crafts. These additional lessons are included in tuition.
